- 1) **NAME OF THE SOCIETY/ ASSOCIATION** : HARYANA STATE YOGA ASSOCIATION
- 2) **REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE SOCIETY** : Flat No. 501, GH-93, Sector-20,
Panchkula - 134116 (Haryana).
- 3) **JURISDICTION** : The jurisdiction of the Association shall extend all over the State of Haryana.
- 4) **AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY** :
 - a) To promote encourage, popularize, standardize and supervise Yoga/Yogasana activities in the State of Haryana.
 - b) To encourage the affiliation of District Yoga Associations / Autonomous bodies in the State of Haryana.
 - c) To organize and supervise the State Yogasana Sports Championships, Yoga Camps, Yoga Seminars, Yoga Clinic and other Yoga contests.
 - d) To arrange, regulate and if necessary finance visits of the State Yoga Team in the National Yogasana Sports Championship.
 - e) To select the State Team for participation in the National Yogasana Sports Championship.
 - f) To perform all such others acts as may seem to the Association to be relevant and conducive to attainment of the aims / objectives of the Association.
- 5) **FOUR CONDITIONS AS GIVEN BELOW:**
 - a) The income and Property of the Association shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association as set forth in Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid to or transferred directly or indirectly to the members of the Association.
 - b) No member of the Governing body of the Association shall be appointed to any salaried offices of the Association or any office of the Association paid by fees and no remuneration shall be given by the Association to any member of such governing body except repayment of out of pocket expenditure & interest on money lent or rent for premises demised to the Association.
 - c) The Association by its constitution is required to apply its profits, if any, or other income in promoting its objects.
 - d) If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Association there is after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, it shall not be distributed among the members of the Association, but shall be given or transferred to some other institution having objects similar to the objects of the Association to be determined by the members of the Association at or before the time of dissolution.

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CONSTITUTION OF HARYANA STATE YOGA ASSOCIATION

1. **Name of the Society** : HARYANA STATE YOGA ASSOCIATION

2. **The Registered Office** : FLAT NO 501, GHS – 93, SECTOR 20,
PANCHKULA, HARYANA – 134116.

3. The jurisdiction of the Society is the State of Haryana.

4. **Membership:**

The membership of the Association shall confine to District Yoga Sports Association/Autonomous Educational Institutions/State Level Units.

5. **Membership Fee & Annual Subscription:**

The fee payable to the Association shall be as following:-

- Affiliation/ Annual subscription fee Rs.2,000/-
- Entry fee for the State Championship Rs.300/- for each competitor.
- State Yoga Referees Examination fees Rs. 1,000/

Note:-The annual subscription will be payable by 31st of March, every year. Member/Units who have defaulted in making payment of dues will lose the right to vote, and attend meetings of the Association.

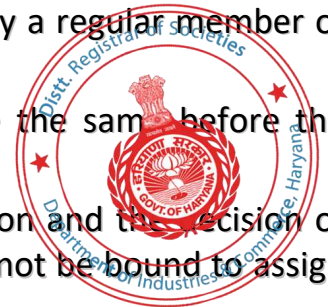
6. **Admission Procedure (for members other than the subscribers):**

- The admission of a person as a member of the Society shall be decided by its Governing Body from time to time.
- An individual willing to be a member of the Society has to submit an application in prescribed form, and along with supporting documents to the Secretary duly filled in and signed and recommended by a regular member of the society.
- The Secretary shall examine the application and place the same before the Governing Body for a decision.
- The Governing Body may accept or reject the application and its decision of the Governing Body in this regard shall be final. It shall not be bound to assign any reason for its decision.

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7. Rights & Obligations of Members:

- (i) All the members of the Society shall be bound by the rules and regulations of the Society as contained in its byelaws and amended from time to time;
- (ii) Every member, except an Honorary member, shall have a right to cast his vote at the elections of the Society provided such member is not a defaulter in payment of any dues of the Society and the annual subscription for a period of three months beyond the due date;
- (iii) Every member of the Society shall have the right to inspect the books of accounts, books containing the minutes of proceedings of the general meetings, meetings of the Governing Body and register of members of the society on any working day by giving a notice of seven days.
- (iv) Every member shall inform the Society about any change in his address, which shall be duly recorded in the register of members of the Society and upon which the Society shall issue a fresh Identity Card to such member.

8. RESIGNATION/EXPULSION/VACANCY OF MEMBERS

A member may be expelled from membership of the society by 3/5th majority of members voting for the resolution, if he is found not abiding by the Rules and Regulations of the society or is found engaged in activities against the aims and objects of the society. A member also loses his membership if he resigns, becomes of unsound mind or convicted of a criminal offence by a Court of Law in India. A person ceases to be a member in case of non-payment of membership fee or fine thereon. A person ceases to be a member in case of non-payment of membership fee or the fine thereon. A person also loses his membership if he does not attend three successive meetings of the society.

The membership of a person comes to an end in case any member dies. Such a vacancy or vacancy created by aforesaid reasons shall be filled by 3/5th majority of members voting. The membership in case of death of a member is not hereditary.

9. RE-ADMISSION

If any member of the society is expelled by the Governing body on the reason of non-payment of subscription fee, he can be re-admitted, providing the member concerned pays all up-to-date dues and fines with the permission of the Governing body.

10. General Body:

The General Body shall consist of the office bearers and two accredited representative of each affiliated unit.

11. Meetings of the General Body:

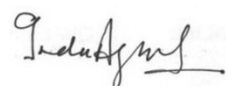
- i) A meeting of the General Body of the society will be held as and when required. However, at least one meeting of the General Body of the society,



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- called as the Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held in a year, within three months of the close of the financial year for consideration and adoption of the duly audited annual accounts of the society in addition to transaction of any other business of the Society as may be required.
- (ii) The Governing Body of the society may convene an extra-ordinary meeting of the General Body of the society at any time after giving due notice as prescribed hereunder, either of its own or within 45 days of receipt of a written requisition along with reasons for convening such meeting, from at least 1/10th of the members of the General Body.
 - (iii) For any meeting of the General Body, a clear notice of at least 14 days along with a copy of the agenda of the business to be transacted, date, time & venue of the meeting will be given to the members of the General Body. A copy of such notice will also be endorsed to the State Registrar.
 - (iv) A meeting of the General Body may also be convened at a shorter notice, if agreed to, by a majority (at least above 50% of the total members) of the members of the General Body.
 - (v) Quorum for the meeting of the General Body will be 40% of the total members entitled to vote and present in person, subject a minimum of four members. In case of a meeting adjourned for want of quorum, the quorum for the adjourned meeting shall not be less than 10% of the total members, subject to a minimum of three. The General Body shall be competent to transact all business in such adjourned meeting except the consideration of any Special Resolution. Any Special Resolution can be passed in such adjourned meeting only if at least 25% of the total members of the Society are present.
 - (vi) The proceedings of all meetings of the General Body will be recorded in the minutes-book (bound or in loose leaves) maintained separately for the purpose by the Secretary and such minutes will be signed by the Chairman of the meeting and the Secretary of the Society.

12. Powers, Functions & Duties of the General Body:

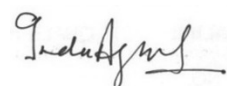
- (i) To guide the Society in determining and fulfilling its aims and objects.
- (ii) To decide policy matters such as change of name of the society, amendment in the Memorandum of Association and the Byelaws of the society, approval of annual accounts of the society, approval for disposal of immovable assets of the society etc.
- (iii) To elect the members of the Governing Body.
- (iv) To remove any member from the Governing Body and according approval to the continuation of a person appointed as a member of the Governing Body against a casual vacancy.



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13. Governing Body :

(1) **Composition:** The Governing Body of the society shall consist of following Office-bearers and Executive Members as under:

a) President	1
b) Vice-President	1
c) General Secretary	1
d) Joint Secretary	1
e) Treasurer	1
f) Executive Members	7

(2) **Election of the Governing Body:**

(i) The Term of the Governing Body shall be three years.

(ii) The Governing body will declare the Schedule of Elections and appoint the Returning Officer for conduct of elections and also notify/display a list of members of the General Body entitled to vote at least 45 days prior to the holding of the General Meeting for conduct of the elections. The Governing Body shall also send notices for holding elections of the Governing Body to all the members, conveying the date, time & the manner. The information w.r.t. holding of election for the Governing Body shall also be sent to State Registrar to appoint an observer, if he so desires.

(iii) Any objections qua the list of members of the Society entitled to vote shall be decided by the Returning Officer in consultation with the office-bearers of the society. However, the decision of the Returning Officer shall be final in the event of any difference of opinion. The Returning Officer shall, thereafter, invite nominations to be filed within the period prescribed in the Schedule of elections, scrutiny and withdrawal of nominations, if any, for election of the office-bearers and the executive members of the Governing Body.

(iv) The Returning Officer will display a list of the contesting members on the notice board of the society. The returning officer will conduct the election on the notified date. The members eligible to vote will be allowed to cast their vote in person, and wherever disputed, on production of the identity card issued by the society.

(v) After closing hours on the date of the poll, the returning officer will declare the results and constitute the Governing Body of the society. A list of the elected office-bearers and the executive members of the Governing Body signed by the Returning Officer, will be filed with State Registrar within 30 days, who shall accord his approval of the same upon his satisfaction.

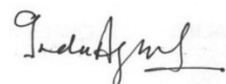
(vi) The office-bearers of the Society shall not be entitled to any remuneration for rendering services to the society.



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14. Filling of any Casual Vacancy on the Governing Body:

Any vacancy arising on account of resignation or death of any member of the Governing Body or for any other reason, may be filled-up by the Governing Body, if required, from amongst the members of the General Body on adhoc basis till the holding of next Annual General Meeting of the Society. Such adhoc member of the Governing Body shall cease to be a member of the Governing Body on the date of the next Annual General Meeting, if his appointment is not approved in the Annual General Meeting by a majority vote for the balance term of the Governing Body.

15. Meetings of the Governing Body:

- (i) The meetings of the Governing Body will be held as and when required. However, the Governing Body shall meet at-least once in a year and there will be minimum one meeting of the Governing Body in a financial year.
- (ii) A clear notice of three days of every such meeting will be given by the Secretary of the Governing Body to the office bearers and members before the date appointed for the meeting. However, the Governing Body may meet at shorter notice, wherever so required, with the consent of at least fifty percent of its members.
- (iii) The quorum of the meetings of the Governing Body shall be at least 40% of the total members of the Governing Body, subject to a minimum of 5 members. In case quorum is not present, the meeting shall be adjourned to another date for which a proper notice shall be issued. The members present in the adjourned meeting, subject to a minimum of three members, shall form the quorum for the adjourned meeting.
- (iv) The proceedings of every meeting of the Governing Body will be recorded in the proceedings book separately maintained for this purpose. Such minutes shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting and the Secretary of the Society. In case the Chairman or the Secretary is not available to sign the minutes, these will be signed by any two members present in the meeting as may be authorised by the Governing Body.
- (v) The minutes of every meeting of the Governing Body will be placed for confirmation in the succeeding meeting of the Governing body.

16. Powers, Functions & Duties of the Governing Body:

- (i) The Governing Body will be responsible for achieving the aims & objectives of the Society and shall work in the best interest of the Society, for which it shall be empowered to deploy the funds & assets of the society for the stated objectives;
- (ii) The Governing Body will be competent to raise funds and purchase property, movable and immovable, on free-hold or lease basis in its name, as decided by it.



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- (iii) The Governing Body shall have full charge of all immovable properties and moveable assets belonging to or vested in the Society and these will be managed in such a manner as it considers appropriate subject to the overall control and directions of the General Body of the Society.
- (iv) The Governing Body shall be competent to invest the funds in the manner it considers appropriate in the best interests of the Society and it shall be competent to borrow or mortgage or hypothecate the properties on behalf of the Society in the manner decided.
- (v) To constitute various standing or adhoc Committees for looking after such functions as may be assigned from time to time.
- (vi) To create provision for engagement of regular or part-time employees of the Society to look after the secretarial, accounting and other functions in a seamless manner.
- (vii) To outsource certain functions e.g. cleaning, security and similar other maintenance activities of the premises of the society.

17. Powers, Functions & Duties of individual members of Governing Body :

(i) President:

- a) To preside over all the meetings of the General Body and of the Governing Body and regulate the proceedings of such meetings.
- b) To do all such acts, deeds and things as may be authorized by the General Body and/or the Governing Body from time to time.
- c) To allow or disallow discussion on any matter which is not included in the agenda.
- d) To ensure proper & transparent functioning of the Society/ Governing Body.
- e) To supervise and guide the overall activities/ achievement of aims & objectives of the Society.

(ii) Vice-president:

- a) To assist the president in carrying out his duties.
- b) In absence of the President, to act on his behalf and perform all duties and exercise all the powers of the President.
- c) To do all such acts, deeds and things, as may be authorized by the Governing Body.

(iii) General Secretary :

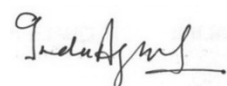
- a) To conduct, organize, supervise and manage all the affairs of the Society and do all such acts and perform all such duties for the working of the Society as may be assigned by the President/Governing Body.



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- b) To receive, scrutinize and place applications for membership of the Society before the Governing Body and to enter the name of the members, if approved, in the register of members under his initials and to intimate the members about the same.
- c) To convene meetings of the General Body/Governing Body with the consent of the President and serve proper notices as prescribed under these byelaws.
- d) To attend all the meetings of the General Body and the Governing Body and assist the President in conducting the meetings and record proceedings of all the meetings.
- e) To prepare annual report of the Society and place it before the Governing Body along with audited annual accounts of the Society, for approval to place the same before the General Body in the Annual General Meeting.
- f) To keep and preserve the records of the Society/ Governing Body.
- g) To help and assist the President in looking after the complete affairs of the Society and in attaining aims & objects of the Society.
- h) To be the custodian for safe custody of common seal of the society and affix the same, wherever required, as per the authorization of the Governing Body.
- i) To conduct correspondence on behalf of the Society/ Governing Body and to sign letters and papers on its behalf and to ensure that all statutory registers and records are properly kept and maintained.
- j) To prepare before announcing of the date of election and the Annual General Meeting, the list of all the members eligible to vote, duly updated and to place it before the Governing Body.
- k) Act as the overall in-charge of the administration and execution of all the programs of the Society/ including financial affairs on behalf of the Governing Body including creation of posts, fixation of salaries/remuneration/ allowances etc., make appointments/ engagement of staff, make purchases and do all other such things as may be necessary in the furtherance of the aims & objects of the Society in accordance with the delegations by the Governing Body from time to time and where no such delegation is specifically made, in consultation with the President of the Society.
- l) The post of General Secretary must be deemed as Public Information Officer. He/she must be liable to reply the RTI under 20 within one month.

(iv) Joint Secretary:

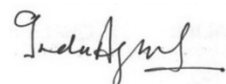
- a) To assist the General Secretary/ Secretary of the Society in carrying out his functions and duties.



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- b) To discharge the functions and duties and exercise such powers as may be assigned and delegated by the Governing body of the societies from time to time.

(v) Treasurer :

- a) To keep accounts of all financial transition of the society and the sums of money received and spent by the society and maintain records of receipt and expenses relating to such matters, assets, credits and liabilities.
- b) To get the accounts of the society audited by the chartered accountant appointed by the governing body at the close of the financial year.
- c) To submit to the Governing Body through General Secretary, the audited annual accounts of the society, at least one month prior to the date of annual general meeting.
- d) To act overall custodian of all the books of accounts of the society, financial statements, receipt books, expense vouchers, bank passbooks and cheque books, cash etc.

18. FINANCE/INCOME/EXPENSES AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS/BANK ACCOUNT

Finance

- i) All receipts and expenditures will be maintained under heads as required under the Income Tax Act.
- ii) The financial year of the society would be 1st April to 31st March every year.
- iii) The Annual Audited Balance Sheet and Accounts of Profit and Loss along with Auditors Report shall be presented by the treasurer to the General Body for its approval.
- iv) Assets of the Society at the time of dissolution will be transferred to some other society having objects similar to the objects of the society to be determined by the members of the society and as decided by the Governing Body subject to the approval of the president who is the final authority.

Income

The ways and means of the income of the society will be from

- i) Affiliation & Entry Fee from the affiliated units.
- ii) Admission, subscription and category fee of each member and
- iii) Donations, special and emergency contributions.

Expenses

- i) The income and property of the society shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the aims and objects of the society as set in the Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly in any way.
- ii) The society of its constitution is required to apply its surplus in promotion of its aims and objects.



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Audit of Accounts

The accounts of the society shall be audited by a qualified Chartered Accountant.

Bank Account

The accounts in the name of the society shall be maintained with any scheduled bank of India to be operated jointly by signatures of any two of the Office Bearers i.e. President/General Secretary /Treasurer '.

19. AMENDMENTS IN MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION AND RULES AND REGULATIONS

- i) An amendment in the Memorandum of Association and the Rules & regulations of the society shall be as per provisions of Haryana Society Registration and Regulation Act. Whenever it appears to the Governing Body of the Society that it is advisable to alter extend or abridge any of its particular purpose or purposes or to amalgamate such society, either wholly or partially with any other society the governing Body shall submit the proposition to the members of the society in a written or printed report and may convene a special meeting for the consideration thereof according to the regulations of the society. However no such report shall be carried into effect unless such report shall have been delivered or sent by post to every member of the society 10 days prior to the special meeting convened by the Governing Body for consideration there of nor unless such provisions shall have been agreed to buy the votes of 2/3rd of the members delivered in person or by proxy and confirmed by the votes of 2/3rd of the members present at a second special meeting convened by the Governing Body at an interval of one month after the former meeting.
- ii) Where a proposition for change of name has been agreed to and confirmed as above a copy of proposition so agreed to and confirmed shall be forwarded to the Registrar of Societies for registering the change of name. If the proposed name is identical with that by which any other existing society has been registered or in the opinion of the Registrar so nearly resembles such name as to be likely to deceive the public or the members of the either society the Registrar shall refuse to register the change of name. However save as provided above the Registrar, if he is satisfied that the provisions of the societies registration Act, 1860 in respect of the change of name have been complied with, shall register the change of name and shall issue a certificate of Registration. The Registrar shall charge the fee applicable.

20. MAINTENANCE OF REGISTERS

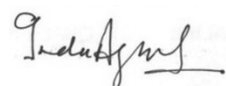
- i) The Secretary of the society shall maintain the following registers for keeping up to date information of the respective areas of the working of the society
- ii) Register carrying the names and addresses of all the members of the society



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- iii) Minutes book for keeping records of all the meeting of the society.
- iv) Account books that are Cash book and ledger shall be maintained by the Secretary of the society.
- v) Stock register shall be maintained by the secretary of the society to maintain a record of the entire inventory of items of the assets of the society.

21. DISSOLUTION

The society shall be dissolved in the manner as laid down in the provisions of The Haryana Society Registration & Regulation Act.

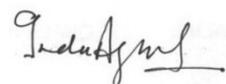
- i) Any member not less than 3/5th of the members of the society shall determine that it shall be dissolved and there upon it shall be dissolved forthwith or at the time then agreed upon and all necessary steps shall be taken for the disposal and settlement of the property of the society, its claim and liabilities according to the rules of the society applicable thereto. If, any, and if not, then Governing Body shall find expedient provided that in the event of any dispute arising among the said governing body or the members of the society the adjustment of its affairs shall be referred to the principal court of original civil jurisdiction of the district in which the office of the society is situated. The society shall however be dissolved only when 3/5th of its members expressed a wish for such dissolution by their votes delivered in person or by proxy at a General meeting convened for the purpose. In case any government happens to become a member or a contributor to or becomes otherwise interested in the society, the society shall be dissolved only with the consent of such government.
- ii) If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Society there remains after realization of its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the society, but shall be given or transferred to some other society having objects similar to the objects of the society to be determined by the members of the society at or before the time of dissolution, otherwise the Assets and Liabilities of the society will be passed on to the government, to be determined by the votes of not less than 3/5th of the members present personally or by proxy at the time of dissolution, or in default thereof by such court as aforesaid.



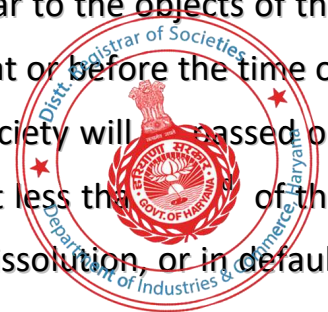
